## This Week's Focus

Reading- Baseball Saved Us- This story tells how baseball improved morale for Japanese-American families confined to a WWII relocation camp. If your child has a harder time with comprehension, a great strategy would be to re-read the story before the Reading Quiz on Friday this selection can be found on pages 218-237. The students have an S.R.G (Silent Reading Guide) with every story. This guide contains vocab words and comprehension questions related to the story.

Religion- We will be discussing Ch. 4- Our Conscience, Our Guide. In this chapter students will learn about conscience and the way it helps them make good choices and brings them closer to God and others. Students will be taking the Ch. 4 test on Friday.

Math-Ch. $4-$ We will be continuing to discuss multiplication. Specifically we will be discussing factors, multiples and the associative property of multiplication. There will be a test on Tuesday, November $22^{\text {nd }}$ which will cover Ch. 3.

Social Studies- We will be continuing our discussion on the Northeast region. We will be discussing the Narragansett, Ellis Island, Seneca Falls, New York and Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

Science - Wrapping up chapter 3 Adaptations with a test on Wednesday. Predator/prey stories due Tuesday. Ch. 4 Body systems - skeletal system, nervous system, muscular system, circulatory system, respiratory system and digestive system.

Lanuguage Arts-We will wrapping up our unit on nouns with a test on Wednesday, November $16^{\text {th }}$. This test will cover singular and plural nouns, common and proper nouns, possessive nouns, capitalization and abbreviations. A great way to review for this test would be to review worksheets and the lessons which can be found in your language arts textbook.
