This Week's Focus

Reading— Will Her Native Language Disappear? – This week we will be reading a Time Magazine selection and discussing cause and effect in a text as well other cultures and languages. If your child has a harder time with comprehension, a great strategy would be to re-read the story before the Reading Quiz on Wednesday, this selection can be found on pages 242-248. The students have an S.R.G (Silent Reading Guide) with every story. This guide contains vocab words and comprehension questions related to the story.

Religion- We will be discussing this month's theme: We Praise God for Saints. Students will be completing a Saint activity. There will be NO RELGION QUIZ THIS WEEK. Math-Ch. 3- We will be discussing multiplication properties and division rules. As these concepts advance it is important that students get more confident in their basic multiplication facts.
