This Week's Focus

Reading-* Students will be taking the unit 2 reading comprehension test on Monday, November 21^{st.} This test consists of three reading passages and comprehension questions that accompany each reading. In order for students to be successful on this test encourage them to read and discuss what they have read with you. Retelling is a great way to check comprehension.

Math-Students will be taking the Ch. 3 test on Tuesday, November 22nd. This test will cover basic multiplication fact and division facts, the properties of multiplication and division, arrays, problem solving, multiples and factors. A great way to study for this would be to review independent practice pages in the math book as well as vocabulary cards.

Science- Continue Chapter 4 Human Body Systems. We will be learning the skeletal system with a quiz on some of the 206 bones after Thanksgiving break. We will also make a connection between the muscular and skeletal system.
